Function:

The role will also include assisting the development of WWF CPO's fishery and aquaculture work, including working on po footprint issues, wrapping up demonstration projects and disseminating conserva achievement to appropriate stakeholders.

Contribute to the conservation of the Yellow Sea Ecoregion by supporting implementation of Yellow Sea Ecoregion Support Project (YSESP) and by dev and implementing the post-YSESP work plans in China. Tasks include coordi and attending relevant forums, workshops and study tour with partners dom abroad; facilitating the development of network of marine protected areas conservation results; promoting conservation models; developing new propo raising fund.
- 2. Represent WWF CPO in the cooperation with existing partners in the field conservation, particularly UNDP/GEF Yellow Sea Large Marine Ecosystem Prc State Oceanic Administration.
